



## **Guidelines: Generator Deployment & Fueling Work**

### **Standards**

- No drugs or alcohol.
- No guns.
- No pets.
- No riders or passengers.

### **Guidelines**

- Be prepared to work 7 days straight and expect to work 12-18 hour days.
- Mobilization (MOB) pay will be determined per each event.
- You will be responsible for checking in at the yard you are assigned to and then maintaining good communication (mostly texting) throughout the entire event. Your communication is a direct reflection of your attitude toward work. **Good communication = Good worker.**
- During an event, you should check in with the “bridge number” you are given every 30 minutes if you do not receive a response.
- ALL RECEIPTS MUST BE CLEAN RECEIPTS. This means no food, no drinks, no donations - absolutely nothing can be on your receipt other than what you need to be reimbursed for.
- Fuel receipts – **MUST have gallons pumped and price per gallon printed on the receipt.** Any prepaid receipt, or a receipt with something else on it, will not be reimbursed. All fuel receipts must be *clean receipts* like stated above, only fuel and DEF on fuel receipts. These receipts are to be submitted within 48 hours of the conclusion of your work.
- Toll receipts – Must be submitted within 21 days of the conclusion of your work. This includes E-ZPass and toll-by-plate.



## **Guidelines: Generator Deployment & Fueling Work**

### **Equipment - Required**

- 2500 or 3500 truck (8-lug wheel pattern) (gas or diesel).
- 3 hitches: ADJUSTABLE pintle trailer hitch, 2 5/16" ball hitch, 2" ball hitch.
- 7-way trailer wiring MUST work. Also, must have a 7-way to 4-way trailer adapter.
- Smartphone to download AT&T's "MATS GT" app.
- Digital multimeter.
- Electrical 3-prong receptacle tester. (\$6 @ Home Depot)
- Hard hat & Hi-Vis safety vest
- Pants & boots.
- Spill kit. (Or one will be provided upon retrieval of fuel tank.)
- Transfer tank with pump and 50' hose. (Or one will be provided.)

### **Equipment - Recommended**

- Bolt cutters
- Chainsaw
- Common hand tools
- Socket set
- Allen wrench socket set
- Cable cutter
- Multi-colored electrical tape
- Shovel
- Case of water
- Nonperishable food
- Money to function for 7 days minimum (\$1000)
- First aid kit
- Wasp spray
- 12v air pump
